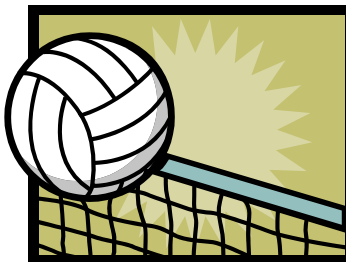

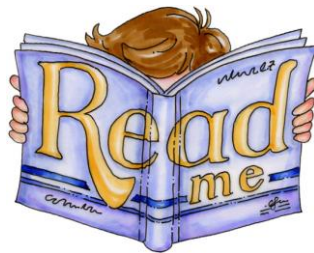
Reading Learning Lab
